Strongyloides stercoralis in humans and in dogs-are they all the same?

According to recent estimates about 600 million people are currently infected with the intestinal nematode Strongyloides stercoralis. In addition to parasitic adults, which are all females and reproduce by parthenogenesis, these worms can also form non-parasitic adult generations which consist of females and males. Although S. stercoralis infections are frequently associated with no or only minor symptoms, strongyloidiasis can take a fatal progression, in particular in people with a weakened immune system. It has been known for a long time that in dogs Strongyloides worms most similar to human S. stercoralis can be found and that dogs can be experimentally infected with human derived S. stercoralis. Therefore, generally, Strongyloides spp. in dogs are considered to belong to the species S. stercoralis. If so, dogs might serve as a reservoir for human infective S. stercoralis. We sampled S. stercoralis from humans and from dogs in various geographic places and used molecular genetic markers and whole genome sequences from single worms to compare them. We, and others, found that dogs carry worms indistinguishable from the ones found in humans along with one or several types not present in humans. Different populations of S. stercoralis showed very different tendencies to form non-parasitic adults. I will present our findings and discuss, from the point of view of a biologist, the questions to what extent strongyloidiasis is a zoonotic disease and if what is generally considered to be S. stercoralis is actually a complex of multiple, closely related species.
